The 5:00 PM Contemporary Mass will now be held in the Worship Space and will also be Livestreamed on our website.


Mass will take place in and around the picnic pavilion. For ease of access, you should plan to park in the back parking lot.





Please plan to bring your own lawn chair to sit on during Mass.






Tonight, October 3, 2021 there will be NO 5:00 PM Mass or LIFE TEEN.
