Background: Each year, Holy Martyrs coordinates a Turkey Run food drive to help our parishioners and Saint Augustine Parish and Hunger Center enjoy a traditional Thanksgiving dinner. An estimated 20,000 people are fed on Thanksgiving Day at St. Augustine's and a network of 33 other homeless shelters, hunger centers and churches across Northeast Ohio. Holy Martyrs parishioners receive a Thanksgiving basket containing all the fixings for a complete and delicious meal.

Four Ways to Help:

- 1. Drop off a non-perishable 'dinner kit' or 'dessert kit' Sunday Nov. 7, 14 or 21 from 9am to noon.
- 2. Drop off a frozen turkey on Sunday, November 21 from 9am to noon.
- 3. Financially 'buy a meal' via a Faith Direct online donation.
- 4. Participate in the caravan of vehicles that delivers donated goods and funds to Saint Augustine's Church on Sunday, November 21. Caravan leaves at 1pm.




