



We are having an eventful Easter season!

I hope you were as inspired as I was by the large number of people who attended our Holy Week and Easter liturgies. It was great to see so many, young and old, returning home to celebrate with their families. The liturgies were beautiful and inspiring. I am grateful to the members of our pastoral team and maintenance staff who worked so hard to plan and prepare for them, and to the many talented parishioners who created the beautiful decorations and served as ministers during Holy Week and at our Easter Masses.

Things didn't end with Easter. Our children are becoming more excited as their First Holy Communion Day approaches. Our Spirit teens are continuing their commitment to provide sandwiches for the homeless, while HM Cares' adults prepared a wonderful Friendship Meal for the poor at St. Bernard in Akron. Meanwhile, Life Teen members are preparing for their trip to the Covecrest Summer Camp that Life Teen sponsors for teens nationwide.

This week, work finally began on the long-awaited project to update the lighting in our church. The original lighting was sorely in need of new technology and components that will enhance our worship experience. The original church lighting plan was meant to reflect light off the ceiling to create a fuller, warmer environment for prayer. That plan is being restored, showing off the beauty of our wood ceiling and crucifix. And behind the scenes, new control panels are being installed that will make more flexible and cost-effective lighting a reality.

This entire project was funded by parishioners who contributed to the diocesan Heart of a Shepherd campaign. Once the new lighting is finished, our next project will be to update the sound system in the church.

There is a wonderful spirit at Holy Martyrs that you can experience everywhere. Our parish continues to grow as we welcome new members and develop new programs and celebrate important milestones. Updating our worship space is an important part of this.

Pack a bag with some snacks and your Bible, and take a long walk with your family. When you stop to eat your snacks, read your favorite story about Jesus.


Prayer


