

IMPORTANT! PLEASE READ!

Groups supporting abortion have proposed an amendment to change the Ohio Constitution that will nullify provisions in Ohio law that protect preborn children and women. This amendment presents a direct threat to the dignity of human life and Ohio's Catholic Bishops are on record as being strongly opposed.

The vague language in the proposed amendment places preborn children and women at risk of losing the safeguards on their health and wellbeing that Ohio established in law over many years. It would expand abortions in our state.

Pope Francis reminds us that the defense of human life at all stages is foundational to our faith and moral values. He said, "Our defense of the innocent unborn...needs to be clear, firm and passionate, for at stake is the dignity of a human life, which is always sacred, regardless of his or her stage of development.

Recently, individuals have been seen at Holy Martyrs soliciting signatures in support of this amendment that will expand abortions and undermine protections for the preborn. It is an insult to our faith and abhorrent to our consciences that they would attempt to use our church and property to solicit support for an effort that is in clear opposition to the Catholic Church's deepest values and beliefs.

DO NOT SIGN THEIR PETITION. THEY HAVE NO RIGHT TO BE HERE.

What they are doing is deeply objectionable and opposed to the core values of our church in defense of human life.

If you see anyone on our property asking for your signature or soliciting support for this amendment, you are asked to bring it to the immediate attention of any member of Holy Martyrs' Staff.

ANGEL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

In 2021, the State of Ohio created a program to provide tax credits to benefit private and parochial schools and students in Ohio, including the Diocese of Cleveland. *The Angel Scholarship Fund* was created as a Scholarship Granting Organization to facilitate this program in our diocese through the Catholic Community Foundation.

What does the Angel Scholarship Fund do?

The idea is simple. Individuals can make a charitable contribution to the Angel Scholarship Fund; donations are eligible for a state income tax credit. This is a dollar-for dollar tax credit against your tax liability or the tax you owe to the State of Ohio, **up to \$750 for individuals** and **\$1500 for those filing jointly.**

Who will benefit from this Program?

The *Angel Scholarship Fund* will benefit Ohio's **Catholic schools** and **parochial students**, and it will prioritize scholarships for **children in low income families** and **those seeking higher-quality educational opportunities** for their children.

It will also offer taxpayers the ability to reduce their Ohio state tax liability by making a contribution to Scholarship Granting Organizations, such as the *Angel Scholarship Fund*.

Who can contribute to the Angel Scholarship Fund?

Any Ohio taxpayer, single or married, with an Ohio tax liability, is encouraged to make use of this program.

Can my contribution be directed to the school of my choice?

The intent of the Angel Scholarship Fund is to offer donors the option of making

- A contribution that supports schools and students across the Diocese of Cleveland based on financial need ("undesignated gift"), or
- A contribution that is designated to benefit students at a specific Catholic school ("designated gift").
