

Easter Blessing of Food

Join Fr. Steve on Holy Saturday, March 30 at 2:00 PM for the Easter Blessing of Food.

The custom of blessing the Easter foods arose from the strict Lenten fasting of the past, when meat, eggs, fats, and other foods were forbidden during Lent. Easter was thus greeted with great joy as the day when Christ arose and when fasts were ended. The Church's joy and thanksgiving were expressed in this custom of blessing the foods for the first meal of Easter.

Three Sundays in Lent

On the third, fourth, and fifth Sundays in Lent, adults and older children who have been preparing to be baptized at the Easter Vigil will celebrate rites called Scrutinies at the 11:30 Mass. These ritual celebrations are communal prayers offered over these individuals who will be entering the Church at Easter to strengthen and guide them in their lives of discipleship. Importantly, these rites are celebrated in community so we can more fully examine our own lives alongside our new members. They are a graced reminder that all of us are called to continuing conversion throughout our lives.

We invite the entire community of Holy Martyrs to pray for our Journey <u>Candidates</u> (those who will be received into the church or complete their initiation as Catholics) and <u>Elect</u> (those who will be fully initiated through baptism, confirmation, and Eucharist) over the remaining weeks of Lent. We also encourage you to attend the Easter Vigil on Saturday, March 30, as we welcome nine new people to the Church.



Lenten Confessions

One of the most important spiritual practices for all Catholics during Lent is receiving the Sacrament of Penance. To make this available to as many people as possible, this year we have greatly increased the number of opportunities for individual confession.

WEEKDAYS

During Lent, Individual Confessions will be available following the Noon Mass every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday of Lent.

EVENINGS

Individual Confessions will also be available on Thursday evenings from 6:30 to 7:30 pm on March 7th, 14th, and 21st.

An additional priest will be available to help with evening confessions on March 7th, 14th, and 21st.

SATURDAYS

Confessions will be celebrated as normal every Saturday from 3:00 to 4:00 pm.

These increased opportunities for individual confession will take the place of a communal penance service.


My hope is that, by offering more opportunities throughout the season of Lent, more people - adults, teens and children - will be able to participate in this healing sacrament.


