

Sacristans, our Future at Holy Martyrs

Would you like to set the table? All are invited and someone very special is coming.

The Sacristan Ministry involves important behind-thescenes set up for each Liturgy. The word "Sacristan" comes from the Latin word, *Sacer*, meaning sacred.

You may not be aware of how the sacred vessels – the ciboria holding the round hosts, the cups, the cruets of water and wine, and the linens -- come to sit precisely where they are at the start of Mass. You may thank a Sacristan for that! As a sacristan, you will learn what the celebrant is using, when he is using it, and why. It can only deepen your understanding and appreciation of Holy Mass.

If you would like a prayer shawl at the time of your anointing, please let us know when you schedule the anointing and one will be made available to you.




Holy Martyrs Prayer Shawl Ministry


